### A. CALL TO ORDER

District Manager Michael McElligott called the February 11, 2025, Regular Board Meeting of the Hypoluxo/Haverhill Community Development District to order at 9:00 a.m. at the Conference Room at Special District Services, Inc, located at 2501 A Burns Road, Palm Beach Gardens, Florida, 33410.

### **B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION**

Mr. McElligott presented proof of publication that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in *The Palm Beach Post* on September 24, 2024, as legally required.

### C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Mr. McElligott determined that the attendance of the following Supervisors constituted a quorum, and it was in order to proceed with the meeting: Chairman Tom Messler, Vice Chairman Bernard Gatlin, and Supervisors Nick Watson and Brett Osinski.

Staff in attendance were District Manager Michael McElligott of Special District Services, Inc., and District Counsel Scott Cochran of Billing, Cochran, Lyles, Mauro & Ramsey, P.A.

### D. DECLARE VACANCIES AND CONSIDER NOMINATIONS

Mr. McElligott explained that no one qualified for Seats 1, 2, & 5 at the election in November.

There was a **motion** by Mr. Osinski, with a second by Mr. Messler to declare seats 1, 2, & 5 vacant. That **motion** passed **4-0**.

There was a **motion** by Mr. Osinski, with a second by Mr. Gatlin, to appoint Mr. Tom Messler to Seat 1 for a 4-year term. That **motion** passes **4-0**.

There was a **motion** by Mr. Osinski, with a second by Mr. Messler, to appoint Mr. Ash Dehghani to Seat 2 for a 4-year term. That **motion** passes **4-0**.

There was a **motion** by Mr. Osinski, with a second by Mr. Messler, to appoint Mr. Bernard Gatlin to Seat 5 for a 4-year term. That **motion** passes **4-0**.

### E. ADMINISTER OATH OF OFFICE & REVIEW BOARD MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES

Mr. McElligott administered the Oath of Office and went over the Board Member responsibilities for Mr. Messler and Mr. Gatlin. Mr. Dhegihan was not present; he will have the Oath Administered at the next meeting he attends.

### I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

### 1. October 8, 2024, Regular Board Meeting

Mr. McElligott presented the minutes of the October 8, 2024, Regular Board Meeting and asked if there were any changes and/or corrections. There were no corrections noted. A **motion** was then made by Mr. Osinski, seconded by Mr. Messler, and unanimously **passed** to approve the minutes of the November 8, 2022, Regular Board Meeting, as presented.

### J. OLD BUSINESS

### **1.** Consider Tree Trimming Policy

Mr. McElligott reminded the Board that we received the policy from the engineer a day before the last meeting so District Attorney Mr. Cochran did not have time to review and determine if this policy needed to go through rule making procedure or if it could be approved via motion as guidelines. Mr. Cochran stated that it would be appropriate to consider the policy as presented as guidelines.

After some discussion by the Board, there was a **motion** by Mr. Osinski, with a second by Mr. Watson, to approve the Tree Trimming Policy as presented as guidelines. The **motion** passed **4-0**.

### K. NEW BUSINESS

### 1. Consider Resolution No. 2025-01 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2025/2026 Proposed Budget

Mr. McElligott presented Resolution No. 2025-01, entitled:

### **RESOLUTION NO. 2025-01**

### A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE HYPOLUXO/HAVERHILL COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT APPROVING A PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025/2026; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. McElligott presented the budget and answered some questions from the Board. Mr. McElligott pointed out that this budget is showing an increase in assessments of \$82.03 per home due to the rising cost of lake maintenance and tree trimming cost. This increase will require letters to be sent. After some discussion, a **motion** was made by Mr. Watson, seconded by Mr. Messler, and **passed 4-0** to adopt Resolution No. 2025-01 as presented, and set the Public Hearing for the Final Budget for May 13, 2025, at 9:00 am.

### 2. Consider Resolution No. 2025-02 – Registered Agent Change

Mr. Cochran presented Resolution No. 2025-02, entitled:

### A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE HYPOLUXO/HAVERHILL COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT DESIGNATING MICHAEL J. PAWELCZYK AS THE DISTRICT'S REGISTERED AGENT AND DESIGNATING THE OFFICE OF BILLING, COCHRAN, LYLES, MAURO & RAMSEY, P.A. AS THE REGISTERED OFFICE.

Mr. Cochran explained that currently Mr. Lyles in their office is the registered agent for the District, but that Mr. Lyles is in the process of retiring, so a new registered agent from their office needs to be designated. Mr. Pawelczyk is the senior CDD attorney in the office, so they are recommending the Board designate him as the registered agent. After some discussion, a **motion** was made by Mr. Osinski, seconded by Mr. Messler, and **passed 4-0** to adopt Resolution No. 2025-05 as presented appointing Mr. Pawelczyk as the registered agent.

From time to time one or more Supervisors may participate by telephone; therefore a speaker telephone will be present at the meeting location so that Supervisors may be fully informed of the discussions taking place. Meetings may be continued as found necessary to a time and place specified on the record.

If any person decides to appeal any decision made with respect to any matter considered at these meetings, such person will need a record of the proceedings and such person may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made at his or her own expense and which record includes the testimony and evidence on which the appeal is based.

In accordance with the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act, any person requiring special accommodations or an interpreter to participate at any of these meeting should contact the District Manager at (561) 630-4922 and/or toll-free at 1-877-737-4922 at least seven (7) days prior to the date of the particular meeting.

Meetings may be cancelled from time to time without advertised notice.
